It began in 1984, and still goes on today. 35 years of the LGBT movement in Slovenia, through the prism of activism and culture.

SHORT SYNOPSIS

The Magnus Festival - Homosexuality and Culture, which took place in 1984 in ŠKUC, Ljubljana was a turning point for the Slovenian LGBT movement and the beginning of the LGBT Film Festival, the oldest LGBT film festival in Europe. The first years were characterised by club activities (unique in former Yugoslavia) and the organisation of events and festivals. The Slovenian LGBT movement became one of the most progressive movements of that time and is still active today through different forms and organisations.

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

During the entire creative process, it was very important to me that the film is not reduced to a political pamphlet of the movement itself, but that it is placed within the wider social context. I was interested in two aspects: how the Slovenian LGBT movement developed under various types of pressure from various parts of society and how the activism and culture of the LGBT movement influenced the development of the LGBT community and the wider social sphere.
